FRIENDLY REMINDERS:

Smoking Policy: Smoking is prohibited anywhere along the facility not designated as a smoking area in accordance with Guam Public Law 33-121. Please advise all personnel, visitors, and customers not to smoke near the building. There are designated smoking shelters located in the lower parking lot.

Parking: Parking rules are strictly enforced here at the Guam Integrated Air Cargo Facility. Please advise all guests not to park in the fire lines, behind other cars, etc. Vehicles found in unauthorized parking areas will be towed at the owner's expense. Please help us keep the fire lanes and loading bays clear for safe loading and in the event of emergencies.

Visitor Screening: For everyone's safety, all visitors entering this facility are logged in and must provide a valid Driver's License prior to entry. Visitors without proper identification will be asked to park outside and walk/shuttle to the office they are visiting. We appreciate your cooperation in this matter.

Rear Traffic Striping In Secured Area - Complete!

We are pleased to announce that the vehicle lanes and bay markers in the rear of our facility are complete. We thank all of our Tenants for their cooperation throughout the process and appreciate the efforts made in keeping the lanes clear and area tidy. For the safety of personnel, we request to keep the vehicle lanes clear at all times. We also ask that all Tenants use their





designated spaces accordingly so as not to impede onto other adjacent spaces.

New Tenant Lanes Coming Soon

Work has begun to finish the mechanical arms at the entrance of our facility. You may have noticed two lanes with one not in use. We are pleased to announce that by December, we will have the second lane open for exclusive use of our Tenants. All Tenant employees will be issued gate cards that will allow them to drive up to the machine on this lane. swipe their card for entry, and proceed into our secured facility. The left lane will remain open for visitors. This will help solve the congestion at the gate while our Security screens all visitors allowing Tenants to have a separate free-flowing entry point. These upgrades are part of our continued commitment to the security and safety of this facility for our Tenants, their employees, and customers. This program is developing and there will be more updates to follow as we phase in the installation. We thank you for your patience and continued support as we are always working to improve the functionality and efficiency of this facility.

Paint Touch Up/Waterblasting - Update

Due to Typhoon Yutu, paint touchup and waterblasting has shifted to the week of November 26 - 30. The waterblasting will be scheduled on the weekends when traffic is relatively low.
